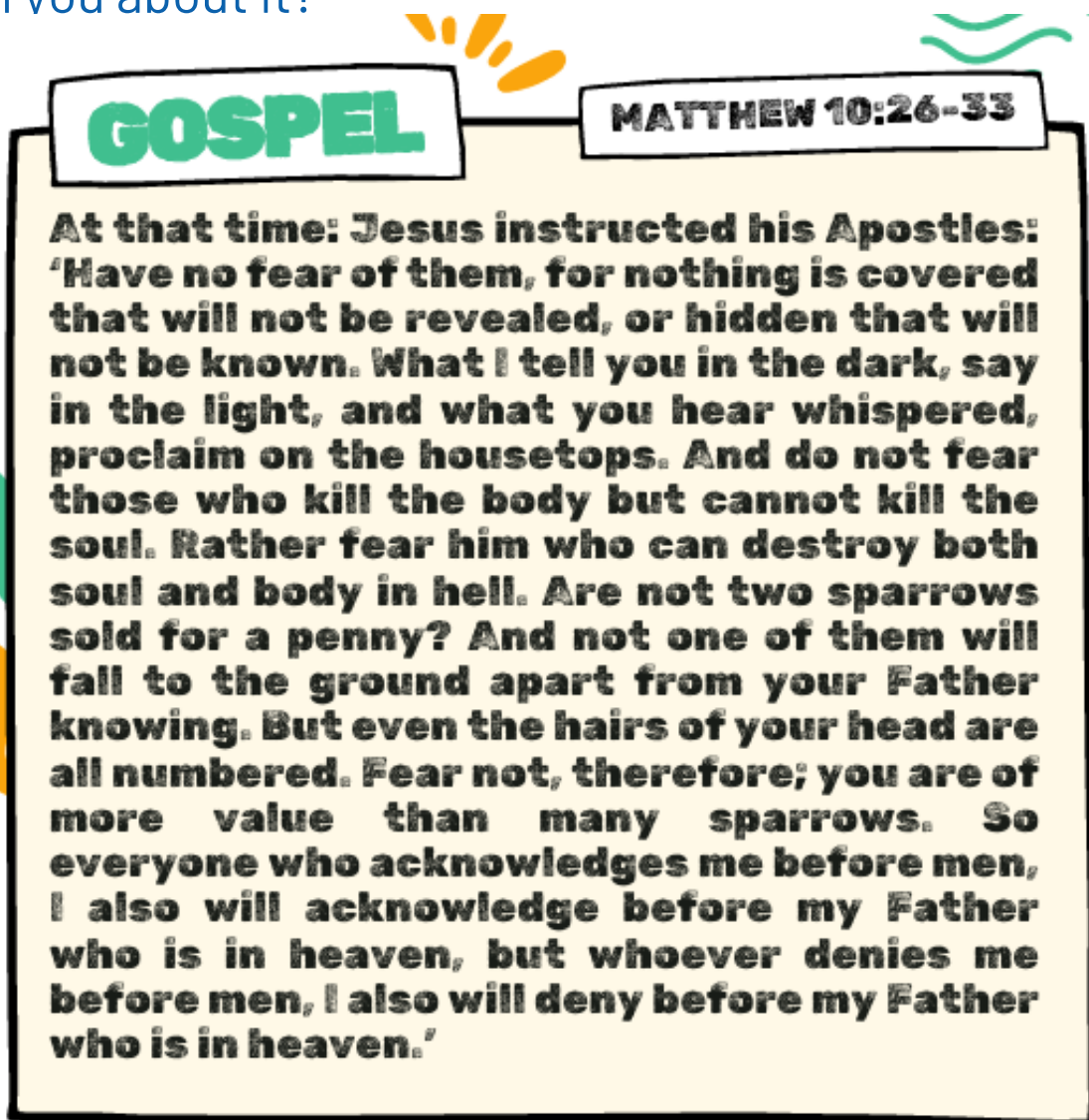

We are all made in God's image and likeness so we all deserve respect.




**Family and Community**

With the recent hot weather, we know that children and families may be tempted to cool off in rivers, lakes, canals and reservoirs. However, open water can be very dangerous, even on warm days. The water is often much colder than it looks, there may be hidden currents or objects beneath the surface, and it can be difficult to get out once in.

Please remind your children never to enter open water unless it is a supervised, designated swimming area and to stay safe around all bodies of water.
