• Home Learning In year 2 children are expected to read their home reading book each night. They will also bring home 5 arithmetic questions to be completed each night. Children are also expected to practice their spellings and their 10 x tables for the weekly tests.

 Fruit costs £1 per week and should be paid on a Monday morning. Children may bring their own healthy snack into school, if they would prefer to.

<u>English</u>

In Literacy this term we will be looking at 'The Storm Whale'. We will be thinking about the characters in the story and we will be writing a Diary entry.

We will have daily phonics sessions. We will be revisiting the phase 5 graphemes, that we learnt in Year 1 and we will learn lots of different spelling rules.



<u>Reading</u>

In Year 2, we will encounter lots of different books and texts.

We will take part in independent and Guided Reading sessions and we will read to our teachers.

We will have a class story at the end of each day and children will bring home a library book each week.



<u>Science</u>

In our science unit this term we are looking at Animals including Humans. We will find out what animals need to survive, the importance of exercise and a healthy balanced diet.



Religious Education

In RE we will know the following stories from the Old Testament: Noah and the Ark, David and Goliath, and Jonah and the Big Fish. We will know the important stories from the New Testament about Jesus, Mary and the call of the disciples, we will learn about Advent as a season of preparation for Christmas and we will know and be able to sequence the story of Christmas from the Annunciation to the flight into Egypt.

We will take part in class and whole school worship and say daily prayers.

<u>Maths</u>

In maths we will be learning how to solve calculations using all four operations. We will focus on place value and sequencing and we will learn how to solve maths problems

We will learn properties of 2D and 3D shapes including edges, vertices and faces and line symmetry .

We will also be learning about money, including recognising amounts and solving problems with money.



<u>History</u>

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In History we are learning all about the Great Fire of London. We will be learning about how the fire started and why it spread.

In Geography will be looking at the 4 countries that make up the United Kingdom and the 7 continents of the world.
