- How can you help at home....
- Listen to your child read regularly and discuss what you have read.
- Read to your child.
- Talk to your child about what they have been doing at school—what they are enjoying or even finding tricky.
- Help your child to learn their timetables .(x2, x5 and x10).
- Remind them to hand in their homework and reading books each week.
- Send your child to school prepared for the day; PE kit, full uniform etc.
- Encourage them to start having independence for their own belongings.

Literacy

In Literacy this term we will be looking at the following fiction units: An extended text—George's Marvellous Medicine by Roald Dahl.

In Non Fiction we will be able to writing a non chronological report and an Explanation Text.

In spelling we will learning lots of different spelling rules, with a focus on the suffixes: -ly, -er and -est, -ment, -ness, -ful and-less.
