

- How can you help at home....
- Listen to your child read regularly and discuss what you have read.
- Read to your child.
- Talk to your child about what they have been doing at school—what they are enjoying or even finding tricky.
- Help your child to learn their timetables (.x2, x5 and x10).
- Remind them to bring and hand in their reading book everyday.
- Send Library books back to school on a Wednesday.
- Remind them to hand in their fluency and spelling books on a Friday.
- Send your child to school prepared for the day: PE kit, full uniform etc.
- Encourage them to start having independence for their own belongings.



Things to Note. . .

- Reading Books are changed on a Monday or a Thursday. Children need to bring their reading book and diary everyday.
- PE is on a Wednesday and a Friday.
- Spellings are given a Friday for a test on the following Thursday.
- This term we will be focusing on the 5 x table. Times tables are tested on a Tuesday.
- Children should bring their Fluency books home each day to complete their daily Fluency homework. Children need to bring their books back to school on a Friday, when they will be marked.

Literacy

In Literacy this term we will be looking at the following texts -

Inside the Villains
Peculiar Pets

We will be writing an explanation text inspired by the book 'The Sea beneath My Toes'.

In spelling we will be learning lots of different spelling rules, with a focus on the suffixes: -ly, -er and -est, -ment, -ness, -ful and -less.

Reading— Children will take part in daily Reading Skills sessions to help them to develop fluency and comprehension skills.

They will share a book as a class at the end of each day and will visit the library once a week, where they can select a book to take home.

Religious Education

This term we will learn about the season of Easter and the symbols associated with it.

We will learn about Pentecost and the coming of the Holy Spirit.

We will also learn about The Mass and Our Church.

We will take part in class and whole school worship and say daily prayers.



Maths

In maths we will be looking at Fractions and Time.

We will be learning about position and direction and statistics.

We will be looking at problem solving methods along with mental addition and subtraction.



Geography

We will be learning about villages, towns and cities. We will be looking at different features of each type of settlement.



Science

Our science units this term will be:

- Living Things and their habitats

We will look at different habitats around the world and how they provide for the animals that live in them.



PHSE

We will be continuing with our 'Jigsaw learning', where we will be thinking about how to keep our minds healthy and happy.



History

We will be looking at the monarchy this half term. We will focus on the reign of Queen Elizabeth II and looking at life in the 1950s.

We will be learning about the Queen's Platinum Jubilee and the Coronation of King Charles.



D&T

In D&T we will be completing our 'Food Technology' unit. Where we will be looking at how food gets from the farm to our plates. We will be designing and making Frittatas.



Art

In Art we will be learning to 'be an architect' and will create models using construction materials.
