Welcome to Nursery at St. Joseph's Catholic Academy.

Your child starting 'big school' is a momentous occasion in their and your lives, so we hope to make the transition into school happy and successful. We aim to support the children in their growing confidence and independence from the very beginning.

Everyday is exciting and full of new learning opportunities in Nursery.

Our theme this half-term is 'All About Me'.



Mathematics

To begin with, the children will explore colours.

We will then move on to matching objects which are the same colour, size or shape.

Next, the children will learn to sort objects by size, colour and shape. Children will use gestures and language such as bigger/little/small.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Our focus initially is to establish routines and build relationships. Children will become familiar with the environment this half term.

Children will be learning independence when going to the toilet, washing hands and accessing water bottles.

Physical Development

PE lessons will be on Mondays and Wednesdays to develop gross motor skills.

Please ensure earrings are removed before school on these days.

PE kits should be at school ready to be used, but we will begin by just changing into PE trainers.

Communication and Language

We will learn a new nursery rhyme each week. A copy will be sent home with your child, so that you can learn them at home too. We will begin with these this half-term:

1 potato, 2 potato, 3 potato, 4

5 Little Speckled Frogs

5 Little Ducks went Swimming One Day

5 Currant Buns

5 Fat Sausages

Understanding the World

We will learn the days of the week as part of our morning routine. We will also discuss the weather.

Our autumn walks will enable the children to explore nature.

Literacy

Here's some of the texts we'll explore:

The Colour Monster

Goldilocks and the Three Bears

A non-fiction book called 'Autumn'

Expressive Arts and Design

The children will have a weekly music session with Mrs Cliffe on Thursdays where they will be exploring sounds using voices, body percussion and instruments. Mrs Cliffe is our music teacher across the school.

This term, the nursery children will also take part in Soundpots delivered by Mrs Davies from the City Music Service.

RE

We will talk about some of the natural world we can see outside linked to God's creations.

We will begin to learn our morning prayer.



Items to Remember
