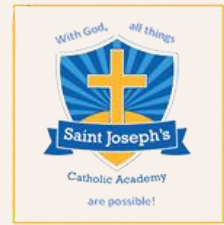


YEAR TWO SPRING 2026

Good to know...

When do we need Fluency Books, Reading Logs and Home Spelling Books?

How can I support my child at home?

Homework

Reading - please encourage your child to read their book at home for at least 15 minutes every day and to write a comment in their reading log.

Fluency - the children will have 5 maths fluency questions to complete per day. They will need to complete them at home each night. These should take around 5 minutes to complete.

Spelling - practise the weekly spelling words with your child in a range of different ways.

RE Homework Projects - Once per half-term, there will be a creative RE homework project to complete with your child.
