

Things to Note. . .

- How can you help at home....
- Listen to your child read regularly and discuss what you have read.
- Read to your child.
- Talk to your child about what they have been doing at school—what they are enjoying or even finding tricky.
- Practice times tables with your child. Focusing on 2, 5 and 10 x tables.
- Remind them to hand in their homework and reading books each week.
- Send your child to school prepared for the day: PE kit, full uniform etc.
- Encourage them to start having independence for their own belongings.



- Reading Books are changed on a Monday and a Thursday but children should bring in their reading books and diaries everyday.
- **PE is on Wednesdays and Fridays**
- Fruit costs £1.00 per week.
- **Homework**— Children receive Maths, English or RE Homework each week, that must be completed. Additional Homework tasks, that the children may choose to complete can be found on the Homework grid in the children's books.
- Weekly spellings are set on a Monday for the test on the following Monday.
- Times tables Test - This term we will be focusing on the 5 times table. Children take part in a times table test each Friday.

English

In English this term we will continue to look at characters from Traditional Tales. We will also be looking at poetry and will be writing our own animal poems, inspired by the poetry book 'Peculiar Pets'

We will then move on to looking at Explanation texts and non-chronological reports.

In Grammar and Spelling sessions we will continue to learn different word classes, types of sentences, how to join sentences with conjunctions and how to write more interesting sentences using adjectives and expanded noun phrases.

As always, we will be focusing on presentation and handwriting and encouraging the children to take care and pride in their work.

Religious Education
