

Things to Note. . .

- How can you help at home....
- Listen to your child read regularly and discuss what you have read.
- Read to your child.
- Talk to your child about what they have been doing at school—what they are enjoying or even finding tricky.
- Help your child to learn their timetables (x2, x5 and x10).
- Remind them to hand in their homework and reading books each week.
- Send your child to school prepared for the day: PE kit, full uniform etc.
- Encourage them to start having independence for their own belongings.



- Reading Books are changed on a Monday, and a Thursday but children should bring in their reading books and diaries everyday.
- PE is on a Monday and a Wednesday.
- Spellings are given a Monday for a test on the following Monday.
- This term we will be focusing on the 2 x table. Times tables tests are tested on a Friday.
- Fruit costs £1.00 per week.
- Homework—Children are expected to complete one piece of homework each week. An optional homework grid will also come home each week and children may choose to complete additional homework activities. Homework books should be handed in on Wednesdays.

Literacy

In Literacy this term we will be looking at the following fiction units: An extended text—George's Marvellous Medicine by Roald Dahl, In Non Fiction we will be able to write a non chronological report and an Explanation Text.

We will have daily phonics/spelling sessions where we will learn lots of different spelling rules, with a focus on the suffixes: -ly, -er and -est, -ment, -ness, -ful and -less.

Handwriting—We expect the children to begin to adopt a cursive style of handwriting this year with all letters beginning on the line.

Reading—We continue to have guided reading sessions, one to one reading and visit the school library once a week to select a book to take home.

Religious Education

We will learn a range of parables and miracles of Jesus and also learn about special celebrations that we take part in.

We will learn about the Season of Lent and Easter and the symbols associated with it.

We will take part in class and whole school worship and say daily prayers.



Maths

In maths we will continue to become secure in addition of subtraction of 2digit numbers. We will start to look at multiplication and division.

We will learn to recognise, find, name and write fractions $\frac{3}{4}$, $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{2}{4}$ and $\frac{1}{2}$ of a length, shape, set of objects or quantity.. Write simple fractions for example $\frac{1}{2}$ of 6 = 3 and recognise the equivalence of $\frac{2}{4}$ and $\frac{1}{2}$.

In mental maths we will become increasingly confident in recalling our x2,x5, and x 10 tables.
